

vim - text editor

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Favourite config

edit config

```
vi ~/.vimrc
```

```
syntax on  
colorscheme desert  
highlight Comment ctermfg=Cyan guifg=Cyan
```

Changing the scheme

Inside of editor

```
:colorscheme [tab]
```

Once happy, add to the config

Indent text in vim

Using VISUAL mode

before you want to ensure you prefer TABs or SPACEs (and you not prefer TABs).

```
set expandtab
```

Define depth of indentation.

```
:set shiftwidth=2
```

Enable VISUAL mode `v`, select text, press `>`

without VISUAL mode

Enable numbering

```
:set number
```

Command below will indent lines 9--16 by width configured above.

```
9,16>
```

(I use it to correct 2 spaces into 4 spaces.)

undo is your friend, press `u`
